The Derby Deets

- ◆ One car entry per person
- ◆ Enter one divisions:
- ◆ Open Pack division is open to all cub scouts in all 3 districts and out of council Cubs. Scouts first in their den in the 7 Rivers District, must enter pack champ division.
- ◆ Open Family Division is open to siblings, adults, Boy Scouts, Venturers, non-scouts
- ◆ Walk-in's are welcome

Pinewood Derby Official Rules

All cars must pass the following inspection (9:00-9:45am)
on race day to qualify for the race :

1. Width shall not exceed 2-3/4 inches.
2. Length shall not exceed 7 inches.
3. Weight shall not exceed 5 ounces.
4. Axles, wheels, and body must be from the materials provided in the kit.
5. Wheel bearings, washers, and bushings are prohibited.
6. No lubricating oil may be used. Axles may be lubricated with powdered graphite or silicone (**lubricate prior to arriving...no graphite or silicone authorized in Mall**)
7. The car shall not ride on any kind of spring.
8. The car must be free-wheeling, with no starting devices.
9. The wheelbase may not be extended; use the pre-drilled holes.
10. No loose materials of any kind are allowed in the car.

Additional District Race Day Rules

- Once a car passes inspection and is entered into the race, it is “impounded” and only race committee members may handle it.
- If a car loses a wheel, or is otherwise damaged during a race, the racer shall have 5 minutes to make repairs in our “Pit Garage”.
- Each car must pass inspection by the official inspection committee before it will be allowed to compete.
- The Inspection Committee has the responsibility to disqualify those cars that do not meet the above listed official rules.
- *Any additional rulings necessary to ensure an efficient, fair and fun race day will be issued by the Seven Rivers District Executive and will be considered final.*
